NCASC's Approval

- NCASC meeting on 15 Oct 2015 approved the extension of RCAR to all-cargo aircraft operators and State regulation of consignors.
 - To comply with International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO) Annex 17 Standards 4.6.1, 4.6.5 and 4.6.2, implemented on 15 Jul 2013.

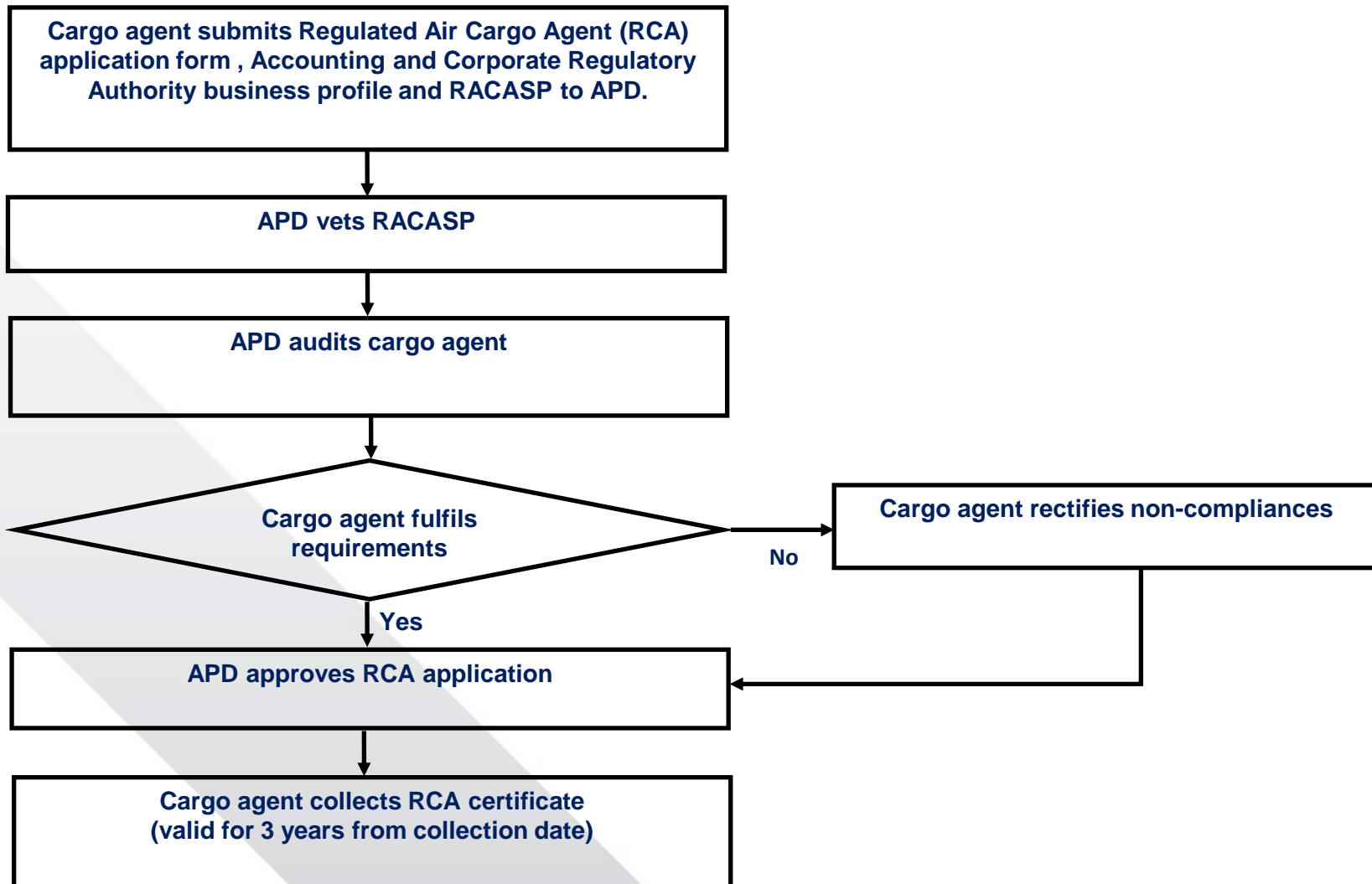
Recap on RCAR

- Implemented on 1 Apr 2008 to secure handling, transporting and storage of cargo on passenger aircraft departing from Singapore.
- Governed by Air Navigation (Regulated Air Cargo Agents) Order [AN(RACA)O].
- Administered to air cargo agents.

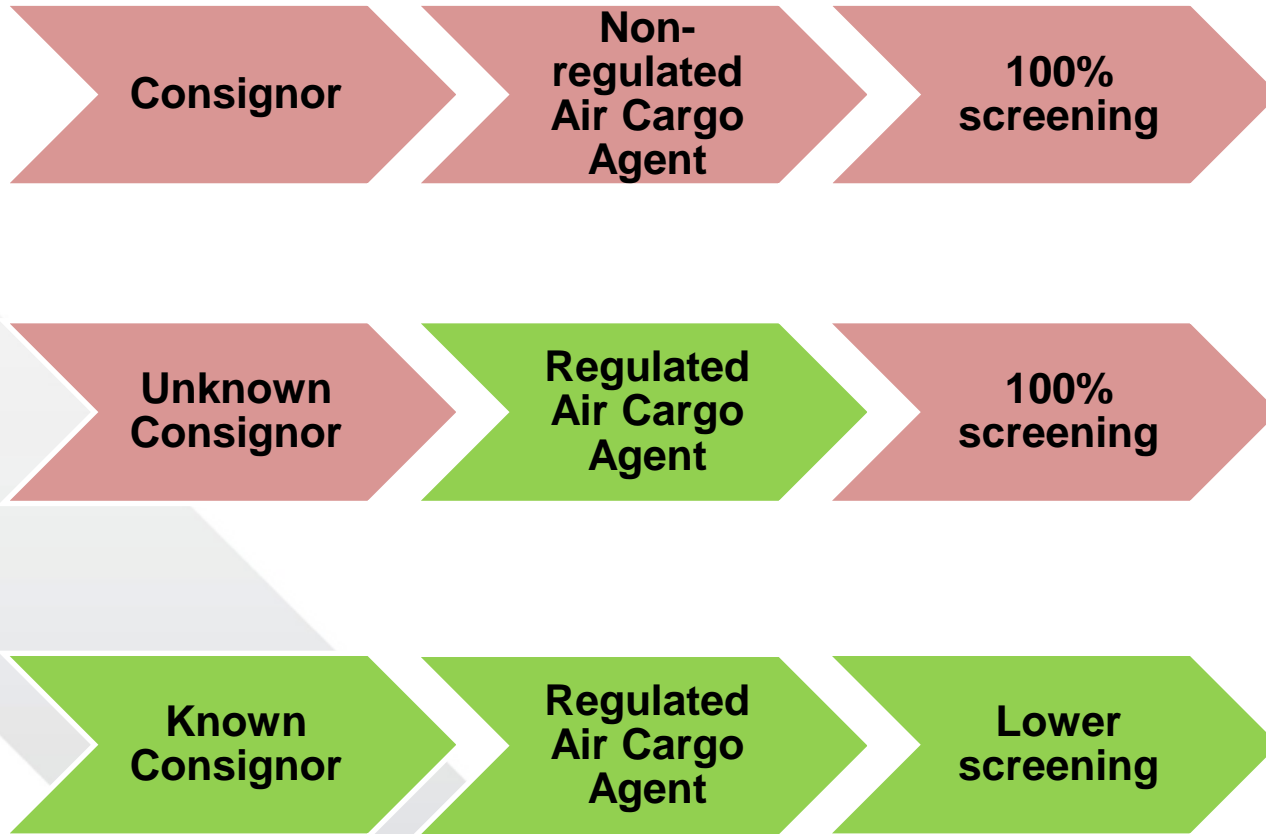

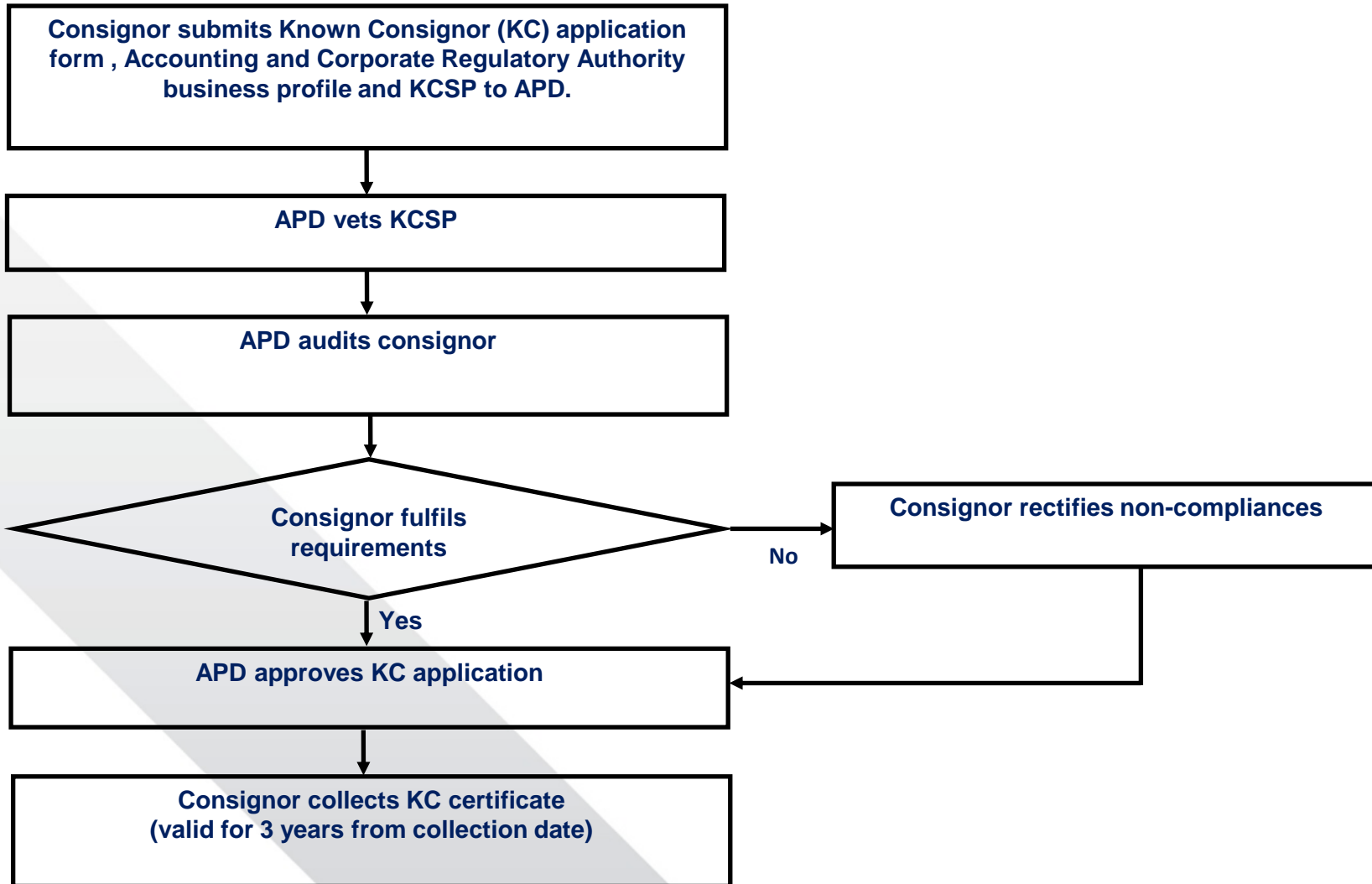
State Regulation of Consignors

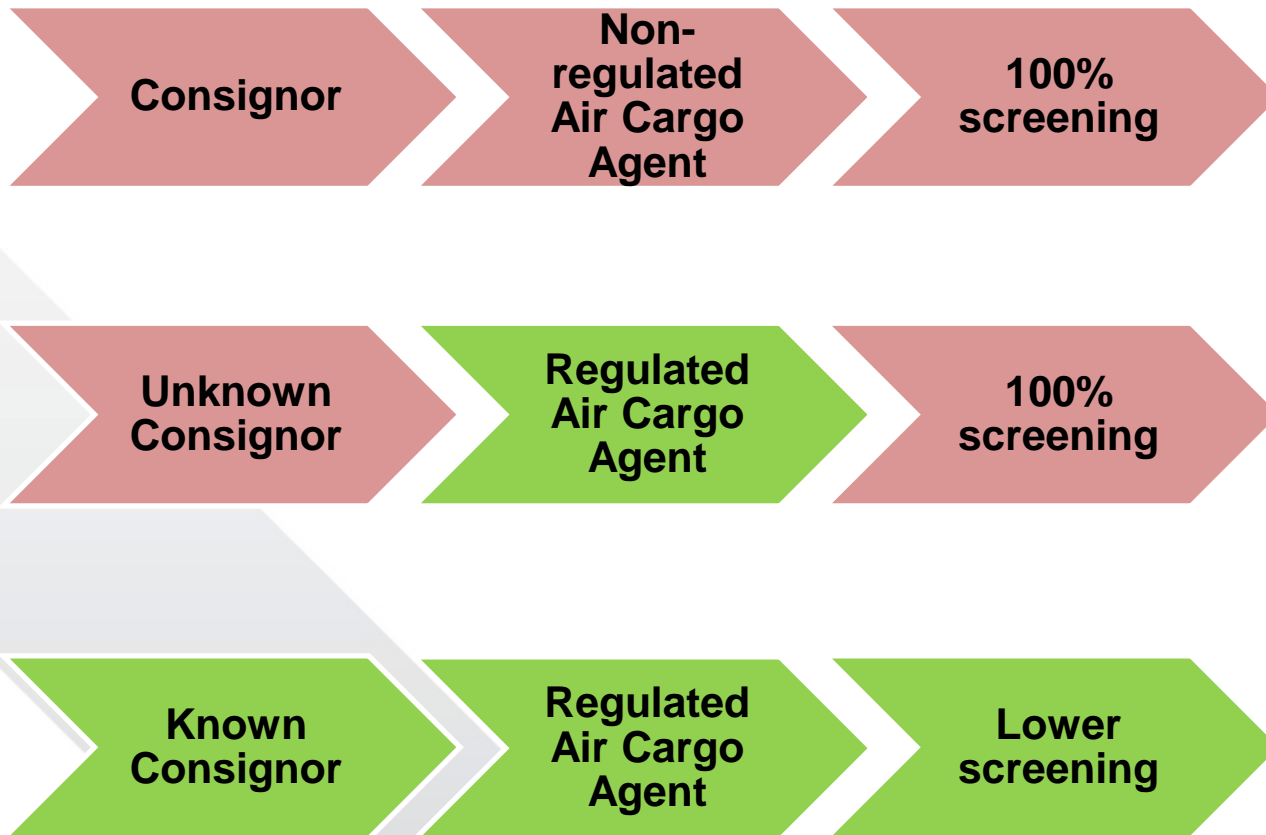
State Regulation of Consignors (Certification)



State Regulation of Consignors (Other KC Qualifications)

- Consignors may also qualify as KCs if they possess the following certifications:
 - Singapore Customs Secure Trade Partnership / Secure Trade Partnership Plus
 - Transported Asset Protection Association Air Cargo Security Standards Level 1
 - United States Customs-Trade Partnership Against Terrorism Tier 2 / 3
