

ELDERLY PEDESTRIANS AND MOTORCYCLISTS REMAIN VULNERABLE

They account for a disproportionate number of traffic accidents and fatalities.

Over-represented in pedestrian fatalities (44%), despite overall decrease in number of accidents and fatalities
